TODAY – FMC welcomes guest preacher Dr. Safwat Marzouk, Associate Professor of Old Testament/Hebrew Bible at Associated Mennonite Biblical Seminary (Elkhart, IN). Dr. Marzouk grew up where interfaith dialogue among Christians, Jews and Muslims influences daily life. As a Christian in Egypt, he focused on studying the Old Testament to better understand God's vision of shalom.
