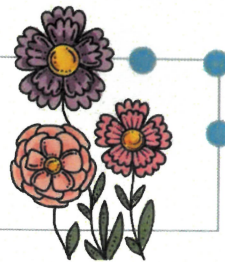

This will be a class with Cliff Notes, discussion, and guests from our congregation who have lived the history of which we will speak.

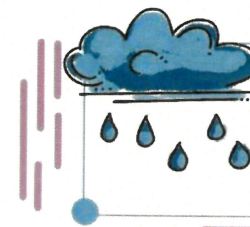

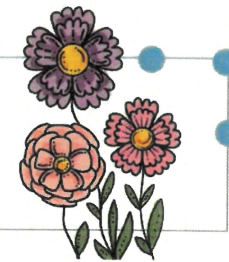
